

Following these simple tips when collecting information and providing specifications for your next project will allow us to provide you with an accurate quote as quickly as possible.

1. INCLUDE A PROJECT NAME

Assigning your project a name at the time of quoting makes it easier for us to find when your project gets approved.

2. PROVIDE AN ESTIMATED PROJECT TIMELINE

Including an estimated deadline for the final project at the time of quoting allows us to alert you if the project approvals and/or production files will need to be “rushed” in order to meet your dates.

3. BE SURE TO EXPLAIN THE APPLICATION LOCATION FOR THE WINDOW FILM

Noting if the film will be installed on an interior (inside of the building) or exterior surface (outside exposed to the elements) will allow us to quote the proper type of film for each specific project.

4. TAKE PRECISE MEASUREMENTS OF THE GLASS WINDOW OR SURFACE

Providing specific dimensions of each glass area in inches allows us to calculate the project’s total square footage of film, and quantity of finished pieces. If multiple windows or surfaces are the same dimensions, please be sure to indicate the specific quantity for each size.

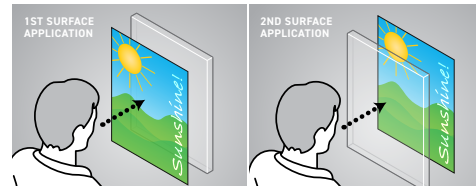
5. INCLUDE ON-SITE PHOTOS, IF POSSIBLE

Providing photos will allow us to better discuss the project with you, ask any questions, or flag any concerns right away. Photos may be uploaded within the Quote Request Form or emailed directly to your Source One Digital sales representative.

6. SELECT A SURFACE APPLICATION

Choosing to install the film on the inside or outside of the glass (first or second surface) isn’t essential for quoting, but it is critical to know prior to production.

Including this detail up front will ensure the film is produced properly once the project is approved.



7. LET US KNOW IF YOU NEED HELP WITH GRAPHIC DESIGN

Will you be providing production-ready artwork or do you want our Design Team to create the files at your direction? Please provide specifics about the scope of the design requested.

Including design details will help us determine what types of inks will be needed. For example:

- Frost (patterns or solid)
- Gradients/Fades
- Photographic or multi-color graphics including branding, logos, or other patterns

8. INCLUDE ANY ADDITIONAL PROJECT DETAILS

For example:

- Mullion measurements, where applicable
- Bleeds requested on finished film sections (extra material around perimeter to be trimmed at the time of install)
